

How Are Dental Implants Placed?

The gum is gently folded back and a space is prepared for the implant to be placed.

The dental implant anchor is placed.



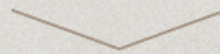

A temporary cap is placed on the implant and the gum tissue is repositioned. The implant is left for several months to heal, assuring that the implant can become secure.



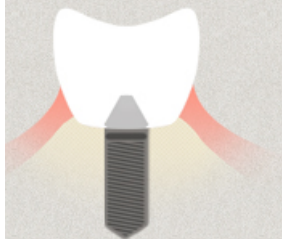

Once the implant has successfully integrated with the bone tissue a new post is attached to the anchor and the area is prepared for the prosthesis.

An impression is taken of the implant and the appropriate prosthesis (crown, bridge, overdenture) is made.

The prosthesis is attached to the implant.
